### Chasing Greatness

**Chasing Greatness** tells the story of how Lewis Howes, best-selling author and host of the self-help podcast *The School of Greatness*, overcame adversity, fear and self-doubt to inspire others to dream big.

Howes overcame feeling dumb, lonely and bullied for being in special needs classes by dedicating himself to becoming the best athlete he could be. He went on to play professional Arena Football for one season, but then suffered a career ending injury.

Broke, depressed and living on his sister’s couch for more than a year, he began reaching out to highly accomplished individuals, asking them to share the story of their success. These interviews gave Howes new direction and became the basis for his popular podcast, with more than 300 million downloads to date.

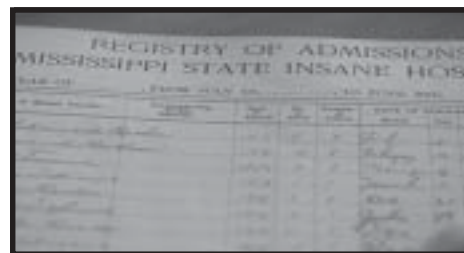

### The Bat Man of Mexico

Narrated by David Attenborough, "The Bat Man of Mexico" on **Nature** introduces ecologist Rodrigo Medellin, who first kept bats in his bathroom as a child and has dedicated his life to saving them.

Now, Mexico's most famous export, tequila, is at stake. Tequila is obtained through the distillation of juices from agaves, and bats are the main pollinators of agave plants. More than a quarter billion liters of tequila were exported from Mexico in 2020.

Medellin's beloved lesser long-nosed bat is crucial to the liquor. To save these bats from extinction, Medellin must track the bats' epic migration across Mexico, braving hurricanes, snakes and seas of cockroaches.

Medellin coats the bats he catches in harmless UV dust, which they lick off and digest. The glowing dust passes through their system and by following their glowing guano across the desert, Medellin devises innovative methods to save the species and the tequila plants they pollinate.

### Mr. Tornado

“Mr. Tornado” on **American Experience** is the remarkable story of Tetsuya Theodore Fujita, a Japanese-American scientist, who devoted his life to unlocking the mysteries of severe storms, and is most

widely known for creating the Fujita Scale, or F-Scale, of tornado damage intensity.

Fujita envisioned a lifetime of scientific research in his beloved homeland, but World War II changed everything. After the bombings of Hiroshima and Nagasaki, Fujita took part in an analysis of the damage caused by the explosions.

In what would be his first damage survey, Fujita realized the significance of the clues left behind by destructive forces. The impressions left from the rubble of Nagasaki and Hiroshima would later influence one of his greatest contributions to severe weather studies.

In 1975, Eastern Airlines Flight 66 mysteriously crashed while approaching New York City’s JFK Airport, killing 113 people. Because other planes safely landed at JFK just minutes before, aviation experts were befuddled by the cause of the accident, hinting at the possibility of pilot error. Eastern Airlines asked Fujita for help.

Fujita proclaimed a new phenomenon as the cause of the accident. He named it a “microburst,” a short-lived, extremely violent downburst of air. This tremendous discovery continues to contribute to the safety of all who fly.

## In the Executioner’s Shadow




