The Celiac Project

- Celiac is a disease that has more than 300 symptoms.
- It is estimated that 1 in 133 Americans has celiac disease.
- 83% of individuals with celiac disease are either undiagnosed or misdiagnosed.
- The average CD victim spends six to ten years going from doctor to doctor before being diagnosed.

The Celiac Project is a documentary about life before and after the diagnosis of celiac disease. When filmmaker Michael Frolichstein was finally diagnosed at age 40 with a simple blood test after years of dismissive doctors, he set out to separate fact from fiction about the gluten-free diet.

Celiac disease can strike at any age among those with a genetic disposition for developing it. In the U.S., it's thought that roughly 2.5 million people are living with it but remain undiagnosed. Symptoms are wide-ranging and numerous. In addition to stomach problems like chronic diarrhea and abdominal pain, signs of the disease might include delayed puberty, weight loss, skin rashes, brain fog,

migraines, fatigue, joint pain and, with young children, failure to thrive. Women with CD suffer more than their share of miscarriages and more often have babies prematurely.

It's not uncommon for people to be misdiagnosed with irritable bowel syndrome and rheumatoid arthritis,

among other things. One person in the film was told she had multiple sclerosis for a decade before she was finally diagnosed with CD.

When someone with CD ingests gluten—even a very small amount—the body's immune system attacks the lining of the small intestine, destroying the fingerlike villi that absorb nutrients from food. Normally, the lining of this organ that connects the stomach and the large intestine looks like shag carpet, with the villi processing food as it travels the gastrointestinal tract. If you have CD, the villi may look more flat. Without healthy villi, people can become malnourished, regardless of how much food they eat.

The Celiac Project airs on 3-2 Sunday, the 29th at 10:00 a.m. and Tuesday, the 31st at 7:00 p.m. On 3-1 it airs Saturday, the 28th at 9:00 p.m., Monday, the 30th at 7:00 p.m. and Tuesday, the 31st at 8:00 a.m.





Niall Ferguson's Networld

Niall Ferguson's Networld, a three-part series, visits network theorists, social scientists and data analysts to explore the history of social networks. From the Reformation and 17th century witch-hunting, through the American Revolution and to the nightmare visions of Orwell's *1984*, Ferguson demonstrates how human behavior, disruptive technology and profit can energize ideas and communication, ultimately changing the world.

In "Disruption," episode one, Ferguson focuses on the great network revolution of our time and one that happened 500 years ago—the Protestant Reformation. He untangles important issues including why social media networks polarize us, why some ideas go viral and why truth itself is at a disadvantage.

"Winner Takes All" looks at lessons from Cold War history, Fritz Lang's *Metropolis*, and George Orwell's 1984, to tell the story of how a decentralized, not-for-profit world-



Then, using lessons from the fight against terrorism in Iraq, Russian attempts to divide Americans through social media, and the rise of an Internet-powered surveillance state in China, "Networld War" focuses on how our democracies are under threat from forces that exploit and weaponize the social networks that we invented.

Niall Ferguson is a Senior Fellow at the Hoover Institu-

tion, Stanford University, and a senior faculty fellow for Science and International Affairs at Harvard. He is the author of fifteen books, including *The Square and the Tower*, a *New York Times* bestseller and the basis for this series.

A History of Christianity is a six-part series presented by Diarmaid MacCulloch, one of the world's leading historians and Professor of History of the Church at St. Cross College Oxford. His books about the Reformation have been acclaimed as masterpieces.

A History of Christianity delves into what it means to be a Christian. Intelligent, thought-provoking and masterful in scope, the series uncovers how a small Jewish sect that preached humility became the biggest religion in the world.

Women's History Month

Frances Perkins and the General Welfare

Summoned: Frances Perkins and the General Welfare is the story of the first woman appointed to a U.S. Presidential cabinet.

In 1911, while visiting a friend in New York City, 31 year-old Perkins witnessed 147 workers, many of them young women, jumping to their deaths from 11th story windows in the infamous Triangle Shirtwaist Factory Fire. After

this tragedy, Perkins dedicated her life to industrial reform.

Summoned:

In her 12 years as Labor Secretary under President Franklin D. Roosevelt, Perkins provided the social safety net that continues to shape the lives of Americans today. During her tenure, she created the Social Security program, a federal minimum wage, the 40-hour work week, unemployment compensation and ended the legal use of child labor.

In the words of Lawrence O'Donnell, "There is no contribution that a cabinet member has made in the history of this country that has had the lasting kind of effect on all of us and the way we live than what Frances Perkins did."

Enemy of the Reich: The Noor Inayat Khan Story Princess, Author, Spy

Enemy of the Reich: The Noor Inayat Khan Story brings to life the story of a woman's extraordinary courage, tested in the crucible of Nazi-occupied Paris.

With an American mother (Ora Ray Baker from Albuquerque) and an Indian Muslim father, Khan was an unusual British agent. Growing up in a Sufi center of learning in Paris seemed an unlikely preparation for the dangerous work ahead. Yet it was in this place of universal peace that her remarkable courage was forged.


When the Nazi's invaded France, Khan was recruited as a spy, going to Paris to support the French Underground. After the arrest of her entire network, Khan became the only surviving radio operator linking the British to the French Resistance in Paris, coordinating the airdrop of weapons, explosives and supporting agents and the rescue of downed Allied fliers.



Betrayed by a French collaborator after four months, Khan resisted brutal interrogation and torture by the Gestapo. She never gave up any information, not even her real name. She was executed in Dachau in 1944 (age 30).






