
Ric Burns' "Pilgrims" on **American Experience** endeavors to tell the true story of a small group of religious radicals whose determination to establish a separatist religious community planted the seeds for America's founding.

The two-hour documentary explores the forces, circumstances, personalities and events that converged to exile the English group in Holland and eventually propel their crossing to the New World. Their early 17th century story is an often misunderstood episode of American and world history.

"From childhood on, Americans are taught to think of the voyage of the Mayflower and the coming of the Pilgrims as the true founding moment of America," said Burns, "and we honor them as such every year on Thanksgiving—even though they came thirteen years after the founding of Jamestown in 1607." The real story of the Pilgrims is far more gripping, poignant, harrowing and strange than the Thanksgiving myth we think we know.

Actor Roger Rees portrays William Bradford, the governor of Plymouth Plantation for more than 30 years and who wrote the definitive history of the early colony. While Bradford's account is a source of much of the narrative for "The Pilgrims," his incomplete telling of their story is filled in by other Pilgrims' writings and by court testimony that include some of the more harrowing and morbid details of their journey and settlement.

As the film details, in the months following the Pilgrims' arrival in the New World in 1620, they would face rampant starvation, disease and death. With people dying faster than they could be buried, they would prop up their sick and dead in the forests to appear

pean fishermen. The Pilgrims believed that God had cleared the ground for them to settle.

Tisquantum, the sole survivor of the former village the Pilgrims now inhabited, lived with them to act as an interpreter and help them plant their crops. In the fall of 1621, under Tisquantum's supervision, the Pilgrims' crops yielded a considerable harvest. To celebrate the bounty and an end to the hardships that had nearly killed them off, they held a three-day celebration of games and food.

Massasoit, the Wampanoag's leader, and 90 of his men joined them. The event was not recorded by Bradford, and only a few paragraphs describe it in another account, which never uses the words "thanks" or "giving." But more than two centuries later it would be imbued with new meaning and inspire a national holiday.

In 1675, Metacom, the son of Massasoit, led an armed effort to drive out the colonists from Wampanoag land. In the end, more than 600 colonists and at least 3,000 Native Americans died. Metacom was killed and the colonists declared a "day of thanksgiving" to celebrate his defeat.

as sentries to ward off potential attacks from native peoples—a transgression left out of most Pilgrims' written accounts.

The Pilgrims' relationship with the indigenous population was complex. They built Plymouth Plantation on a site littered with the human remains of the Wampanoags who had been wiped out by a plague that originated with Euro-

## Abandoning the *Titanic*

Mainstream retellings of the sinking of the *RMS Titanic* on April 15, 1912 often overlook that the "unsinkable" *Titanic* was not alone when it sank. A mystery ship was spotted within view of the sinking ship, but instead of sailing closer to aid the drowning passengers, the mystery ship seemingly ignored a fusillade of signals and sailed away.

"Abandoning the *Titanic*" on **Secrets of the Dead** joins a team of investigators as they search for the identity of the mystery ship that turned away from the *Titanic* in its darkest hour, abandoning thousands of lives to the icy waters.

Four days after the tragedy, the United States launched an inquiry into the *Titanic* disaster, quickly concluding that, based on the testimony of 80 witnesses, Capt. Lord's *Californian* was the only ship the *Titanic* crew and passengers could have seen. Lord and *Californian* crew members faced years of criticism for their role in the tragedy.

On September 1, 1985, the wreck of *Titanic* was found at its final resting place. That discovery exonerated Lord and the *Californian*'s role in the disaster, re-opening accounts that implicate another ship.

It is widely believed that notorious Bronx-based gangster and bootlegger Dutch Schultz buried a fortune estimated to be worth more than \$50 million somewhere in New York's Catskill Mountains. In 1935, Schultz was gunned down and died without revealing where the treasure was buried, spawning a mystery that has endured for nearly a century.

**Secrets of the Dead** "Gangster's Gold" follows three groups of treasure hunters, armed with today's modern technology and decades worth of intensive research, as they follow the trail of this mystery toward the discovery of a lifetime.

Like many during the Great Depression, Schultz didn't trust banks to keep his wealth safe. Instead, he kept it hidden in a strong box that he is believed to have buried somewhere in upstate New York. 


